3. КОНТРОЛЬ ТА КРИТЕРІЇ ОЦІНЮВАННЯ ЗНАНЬ СТУДЕНТІВ

При вивченні дисципліни використовуються наступні форми контролю знань студентів: вхідний, рубіжний, поточний, модульний та підсумковий контроль.

Вхідний контроль (діагностика вхідного рівня знань студентів) дозволяє визначити наявний рівень знань студентів і слугує орієнтиром для реалізації

індивідуального підходу в процесі викладання дисципліни та визначенні форм і методів організації освітнього процесу. Завдання вхідного контролю мають виконати всі студенти. Бали, отримані студентом за виконане завдання вхідного контролю, не входять до суми, яка накопичується за семестр.

Рубіжний (модульний) контроль дозволяє перевірити знання студентів як узагальнені за відповідним модулем. Тестування здійснюється за тестовими завданнями усіх тем, що входять до певного модуля та оцінюються за 100-баловою системою.

Підсумковий модульний контроль проводиться з метою визначення результатів за період теоретичного навчання студентів. Проведення підсумкового модульного контролю з дисципліни передбачене робочою програмою дисципліни як окреме заняття, передбачене робочим навчальним планом і проводиться на останньому за розкладом практичному занятті. Основною формою підсумкового модульного контролю є підсумкова модульна контрольна робота (ПМК). Підсумкова контрольна робота проводиться у формі комбінованого тесту лексико-граматичних завдань, який застосовується з метою перевірки сформованості конкретних навичок і вмінь мовлення. Результати виконання тесту повинні продемонструвати якість і повноту досягнення цілей та завдань, визначених програмою.

Підсумкова модульна контрольна робота оцінюються за 100-баловою системою.

Підсумкові завдання семестру складаються з п'яти частин: аудіювання, говоріння, читання, писемне мовлення. Залежно від цілей і завдань модуля, завдання для підсумкового контролю (тести тощо) можуть з різної структури (тексти, діалоги).

Поточний контроль проводиться на кожному практичному занятті та за результатами виконання завдань самостійної роботи. Поточний проведення усного фронтального реалізується під або індивідуального час опитування, виконання поточних тестів, письмових робіт, написання та обговорення повідомлень, есе тощо, передбачає перевірку та оцінювання теоретичних питань, самостійної роботи, практичних робіт та набутих практичних навичок під час виконання завдань. Більшість прийомів поточного оцінювання спрямовано на детальну перевірку окремих параметрів мови або вмінь мовлення, яких щойно навчили.

Сума балів, накопичених студентом за виконання усіх видів поточних навчальних завдань (робіт) на практичних заняттях та на підсумковому модульному контролі, свідчить про ступінь оволодіння ним програмою навчальної дисципліни на конкретному етапі її вивчення.

Загальна сума поточних балів, яку студент набрав за семестр, а також загальна кількість відвіданих ним занять (2 бали за кожне заняття) є сумою накопичених балів за семестр, до яких може входити індивідуальне завдання (презентація, тощо), участь у науковому гуртку, конференціях, круглих столах, тощо; підготовка доповідей, тез, статей, додатково додають 10-20 балів.

Підсумкова оцінка з дисципліни ϵ сумою накопичених балів за семестр (поточні бали, модульні контрольні роботи). Підсумкова оцінка ϵ результатом середнього арифметичного балів двох модульних контролів (рубіжного та ПМК) та поточних балів. Результат підсумкового модульного контролю виставляється у відомість підсумкового модульного контролю (дод. 2, графи 4)і ϵ визначеним у балах

за 100-баловою шкалою ДТЕУ.За відсутності модульного контролю підсумкова оцінка визначається як сума поточних оцінок у балах і заноситься у відомість встановленої форми.

Підсумковий контроль проводиться з метою оцінювання результатів навчання студентів на певному освітньому ступені або на окремих його завершених етапах. Підсумковий контроль — це підсумкове оцінювання результатів навчання студентів за навчальний період (семестр) та здійснюється у формі екзамену.

Формою підсумкового контролю є екзамен. Екзаменаційна оцінка є результатом виконання 3 питань (2 х 30 балів + 40 балів = 100 балів). Перше завдання (теоретичне — читання, переклад та переказ тексту) — 30 балів, друге завдання (ситуаційне — переказ тексту або ситуаційного діалогу) — 30 балів, третє завдання (тестове -лексико-граматичні тести) — 40 балів.

Метою підсумкового контролю ϵ визначення рівня володіння англійською мовою наприкінці навчального семестру курсу відповідно до поставлених цілей навчання або класифікованих за складністю рівнів навчальних досягнень.

Безпосередньо, критерії оцінювання знань, умінь та навичок мають такий вигляд:

90-100 балів ставиться при регулярному максимально високому рівні підготовки до занять, активній участі у практичних заняттях, вчасному виконанні всіх видів роботи з навчальної дисципліни. Якісне виконання завдань за всіма рівнями складності. (90-100%) має на увазі наступне.

Рецептивні види мовленнєвої діяльності (аудіювання і читання): рівень розуміння мовлення 90-100%.

Продуктивний вид мовленнєвої діяльності (писемне мовлення): повна відповідність викладеного темі; логічна побудова мовлення та розкриття теми; вживаність різноманітних мовних засобів, відповідність обсягу висловлювання вимогам програми.

Володіння лексичним і граматичним матеріалом курсу в повному обсязі не менш 90%); наявність незначних мовних помилок (1-2).

82—89 балів ставиться у разі наявності незначних прогалин у заняттях, що не відбилися суттєво на рівні вмінь та навичок слухача; при незначних помилках під час виконання навчальних перекладів або при незначних недоліках/ неточностях у відповідях на запитання; при цьому студент демонструє високий рівень та вільне володіння матеріалом.

Недостатньо якісне виконання завдань за всіма рівнями складності (80-90%).

Рецептивні види мовленнєвої діяльності (аудіювання і читання): рівень розуміння мовлення - 80-90%.

Продуктивний вид мовленнєвої діяльності (писемне мовлення): повна відповідність викладеного темі; логічна побудова мовлення та розкриття теми; вживаність різноманітних мовних засобів; дещо менший обсяг тексту. Володіння лексичним і граматичним матеріалам курсу в обсязі не менш 80%; наявність мовних помилок (3-5).

75-81 балів ставиться у тому випадку, якщо, окрім зазначених вище недоліків, студент незначною мірою допускає стилістичні, граматичні та інші помилки під час

написання творів або в усних відповідях.

Рецептивні види мовленнєвої діяльності (аудіювання і читання): рівень розуміння мовлення - 75-81%.

Продуктивний вид мовленнєвої діяльності: недостатньо коректна фонетична, граматична й лексична презентація усного чи писемного мовлення. Часткове порушення логічної побудови мовлення.

Володіння лексичним і граматичним матеріалам курсу в обсязі не менш 75%.

69-74 балів ставиться при посередньому володінні студентом навчальним матеріалом (не менше 60%), можливих пропусках навчальних занять, виконанні поточних та підсумкових контрольних робіт не менше, ніж на 60%; при незначних граматичних та стилістичних помилках, неуважності, обмеженості особистої мови та мовлення, пасивності на заняттях;

Рецептивні види мовленнєвої діяльності (аудіювання і читання): рівень розуміння мовлення - 69-74%.

Продуктивний вид мовленнєвої діяльності: недостатньо коректна фонетична, граматична й лексична презентація усного чи писемного мовлення. Порушення логічної побудови мовлення.

Володіння лексичним і граматичним матеріалам курсу в обсязі не менш 69%.

60-68 *балів* ставиться у разі володіння навчальним матеріалом не менше, ніж на 60%, нерегулярного відвідування занять студентами, пасивній участі в аудиторній роботі, невиконанні певних (вторинних) видів роботи; при частому припусканні граматичних та стилістичних помилок, неуважності, бідності та уповільненості особистої мови та мовлення (як результат слабких знань та недостатньої сформованості навичок);

Неякісне виконання завдань за всіма рівнями складності (60-68%).

Рецептивні види мовленнєвої діяльності (аудіювання і читання): рівень розуміння мовлення - 60-68%.

Продуктивний вид мовленнєвої діяльності (письмове мовлення): відповідність викладеного темі; логічна побудова мовлення; неповне розкриття теми; одноманітність мовних засобів; обсяг висловлювання 14—19 фраз/речень.

Володіння лексичним і граматичним матеріалам курсу в обсязі 60-68%; наявність мовних помилок (7-9).

60 балів - ставиться, якщо студент опанував навчальний матеріал менше, ніж на 60%, допускає грубі помилки у мові; має значну кількість пропусків; не може вчасно й якісно виконати запропоновані викладачем завдання.
